As this is not a Licence students from other organisations may still be able to train within any of the British Wado Federation Dojo available to them, without having to jeopardise their position on 'double-licencing' violations/restrictions, etc.

The Use of Temporary Visitors Membership.

Temporary Visitors' Membership can be obtained for a number of reasons. For example, for students who are in the area for a while, but wish to insure but not to licence, as their main Dojo (where they train and grade) is located elsewhere. Restrictions: Restrictions of use include; Gradings, Advancement, Competition, Instructing (whether temporary or permanent), etc.

Insurances - Cover is for Wado Karate related activities, organised within the UK membership of the British Wado Federation Governing Body and BWF member-groups. *Cover does not include training elsewhere and does not allow the use of live bladed weapons.*

British Wado Federation Insurance includes:

1. Temporary Membership to the British Wado Federation and/or member-groups.
2. UK Person to Person and Public Liability Insurance cover for £10,000,000.

Due to the turnover of student memberships in martial-arts it is usually considered that if a martial-arts licence has expired it is normally due to the result of the individual terminating training & membership etc.

1. Insurance cover becomes invalid at time of expiry.
2. Temporary Membership terminated at time of expiry.

Once reapplication has been accepted all records are replaced and restarted at date of renewed application.
